



GlobalMed is a Trenton-based manufacturer of disposable medical components for use in anesthesia, respiratory, and customized medical applications. They make corrugated and collapsible medical tubing and other injection molded components. Plus, they provide a positive pressure-controlled room for assembly and packaging services.

They employed 80 people two years ago, and they have since almost tripled their size to over 200. This success is to generous funding from the Quinte Economic Development Commission's manufacturing workforce development strategy. Funded by the Province's Rural Economic Development program, and co-developed by Quinte EDC and Loyalist College, the strategy provides funding for training and internships to support the local manufacturers like GlobalMed.

They have strong engineering support, R&D Capability, ISO registered Quality Systems and the latest in manufacturing technology.

GlobalMed started as a family company, a sister company of Drossbach which manufactured ducting and automotive tubing. Yet, GlobalMed is a home-town company with long-term employees and strong roots in Trenton. For example, GlobalMed's line machines are all made by local companies. Over the years they have evolved into hi-tech medical supplies. They emphasize precision and quality as if their lives depended on it, and many medical patient's lives do depend on their products. They treat their customers as business partners, and combine their efforts to achieve the highest level of success.
